- Work closely with the Software Developers in the change team to translate specifications and use cases into a set of executable tests and manage the process and outputs.
- Work within the boundaries of the software development life-cycle, including delivery and implementation of releases.
- Document solution designs to the specification agreed with the Lead Software Developer and Head of Change.
- Design and develop a new automated test suite, using existing tools where necessary.
- Manage user acceptance testing, including communicating various business areas to organise testing.
- Maintain the existing application and website functionality through regression testing or continuous integration.
- Work with Lead Software Developer to maintain release management part of software development life-cycle.
- Assist the lead software developer and head of change with the estimation of time to complete software projects.
- Comply with the agreed development methodology and standards.
